1 June 1973 - 5:30 PM

Ring Presentation and Banquet: (Mitchell Hall)

For the Class of 1974 and their male guests only.

Dress: Summer Mess Dress for cadets and military; business suits for civilian guests.

Parking: Under and around Fairchild Hall.

9:00 PM

Ring Dance: (Arnold Hall)

For the Class of 1974 and their guests only.

Dress: For parents, guardians and guests attending the dance, the appropriate dress for the ladies is a dressy dinner dress; for the gentlemen, a business suit. Formal attire for both ladies and gentlemen is certainly appropriate if desired. Summer Mess Dress uniform will be worn by military personnel. A long formal gown, color is optional, with gloves is desired for the young ladies being escorted by cadets. (The short dress is not an acceptable or appropriate formal gown.)

Parking: Available in the lots near the Planetarium.

2 June 1973 - 5:30 PM

Air Force Association Outstanding Squadron Banquet: (Broadmoor International Center)

By invitation only to cadets who are members of the Outstanding Squadron and their fathers or other male guests. Because the banquet is a stag affair, a separate dinner for cadet female guests is planned. Information is provided about 15 May to the Outstanding Squadron cadets and they then notify their parents to determine if they plan to attend. Bus transportation is provided for the ladies who meet at the Broadmoor Hotel; following their dinner, they are returned to the Broadmoor International Center to join their sons and husbands.

Dress: Appropriate dress for the ladies is dinner or cocktail dress. For the gentlemen, black tie is prescribed for civilians; Summer Mess Dress is the prescribed military dress.

9:00 PM

June Week Formal: (Arnold Hall)

By verbal invitation of cadets only.

Dress: Formal.

3 June 1973 - 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM

Chapel Services (Protestant and Catholic): (Cadet Chapel)

Open to the public.

Dress: The appropriate dress for chapel services is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Allowed only in the parking lots near the Planetarium. No guest parking near the Chapel is authorized.

5:30 PM and 7:00 PM

Baccalaureate Services: (Cadet Chapel)

For the Class of 1973 and guests only. Each graduating cadet receives a maximum of four tickets.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Allowed only in the parking lots near the Planetarium and near the Field House. Bus transportation will be provided to and from the Field House parking lots as required. No guest parking near the Chapel is authorized.

6:45 PM - 9:15 PM

Superintendent's Reception: (Arnold Hall)

Honoring graduates and their adult guests only. Special invitations are extended to the Academy staff and faculty.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Parking will be provided in lots near the Planetarium and near the Field House. Bus transportation will be provided to and from the Field House.

4 June 1973 - 10:00 AM

Military and Organizational Awards Parade: (Parade Ground)

Open to the public. Seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis, except for Protocol invitees.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Available in the lots north of the Parade Ground. Bus transportation will be provided from the parking lots to the Parade Ground.

Alternate Plan: In the event of inclement weather, the Military and Organizational Awards Parade will be presented in conjunction with the Scholastic Honors Ceremony in the Field House. Due to the limited space, only cadets and their guests will be permitted to attend.

1:30 PM

Scholastic Honors Ceremony: (Cadet Field House)

Open to cadets and their guests. Seats will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Available in lots around the Field House.

2:20 PM

Organizational and Individual Awards Tea: (Cadet Field House Concourse)

By invitation only to recipients of awards and their guests.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Available in the Field House lots.

5:30 PM

Athletic Awards Banquet: (Mitchell Hall)

By invitation only. This event is in honor of all cadets earning an Athletic Award during the past academic year. It is attended by the Cadet Wing and male guests of those First Classmen who have lettered in a varsity sport.

Dress: Class A uniform. Business suit for civilian guests.

Parking: Under or around Fairchild Hall.

8:00 PM

Cadet Chorale Concert: (Arnold Hall Theater)

Open to the public. Seats will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Available in the lots near the Planetarium.

5 June 1973 - 10:00 AM

Graduation Parade and USAF Academy Airmanship

Review: (Cadet Parade Ground)

Open to the public. Seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis, except for certain Protocol invitees.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Lower cadet parking lots and Field House parking lot. Bus transportation will be provided from the parking lots to the Parade Ground.

1:00 PM

Open House: The Cadet Chapel, Cadet Gym, Fairchild Hall, Field House, and the Aero Science Lab will be open to cadets, their guests, and USAF Academy personnel. Cadet Dorms will be open to guests being escorted by a cadet.

6:30 PM

Graduation Buffet: (Mitchell Hall)

Normally, each graduate is allowed to purchase five guest tickets prior to June Week.

Dress: For parents, guardians and guests attending the dance, the appropriate dress for the ladies is a dressy dinner dress; for the gentlemen, a business suit. Formal attire for both ladies and gentlemen is certainly appropriate if desired. Summer Mess Dress uniform will be worn by military personnel. A long formal gown, color is optional, with gloves is desired for the young ladies being escorted by cadets. (The short dress is not an acceptable or appropriate formal gown.)

Parking: Under or around Fairchild Hall and on the Terrazzo as directed by the Security Police.

5 June 1973 - 9:00 PM

Graduation Ball: (Arnold Hall)

This ball is open to the Class of 1973 and their guests only. Due to crowded ballroom conditions, guests will not be permitted on the ballroom floor until after the receiving lines have ended. Only guests of the Superintendent are permitted on the ballroom floor during the receiving line period.

Dress: For parents, guardians and guests attending the dance, the appropriate dress for the ladies is a dressy dinner dress; for the gentlemen, a business suit. Formal attire for both ladies and gentlemen is certainly appropriate if desired. Summer Mess Dress uniform will be worn by military personnel. A long formal gown, color is optional, with gloves is desired for the young ladies being escorted by cadets. (The short dress is not an acceptable or appropriate formal gown.)

Parking: Cadets - use lots near the Planetarium. Parents - use Officers' Club parking lots and bus transportation.

9:00 PM

First Class Parents' Dance: (USAF Academy Officers' Club)

This dance is held for the parents and guests of the graduating class, and is concurrent with the Graduation Ball. Bus transportation is provided between the Graduation Ball (Arnold Hall) and the Officers' Club at regular intervals.

Dress: The appropriate dress for the ladies is a dressy dinner dress; for the gentlemen, a business suit. Formal attire for both ladies and gentlemen is appropriate if desired. Summer Mess Dress uniform for military guests.

Parking: Officers' Club parking lots.

6 June 1973 - 9:45 AM

Graduation Exercises and USAF Thunderbird Demonstration: (Falcon Stadium)

Open to the public.

Tickets: Each graduate receives seven guest tickets for seats in Falcon Stadium or the Field House. If exercises are held in Falcon Stadium, extra seats will be available.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Around Falcon Stadium.

Alternate Plan: In the event of inclement weather, graduation exercises will be conducted in the Cadet Field House. Due to the limited capacity, only those guests of graduates with invitations will be allowed to attend.

Parking: In lots around the Cadet Field House.

GENERAL ACADEMY INFORMATION

It is suggested that parents and guests consider having sunglasses available for all scheduled outside events, and that all ladies planning to wear an afternoon dress have a light wrap available if cool, windy weather is forecast. Normally Colorado has delightful weather during the month of June - sunny, warm days and cool evenings.

TRANSPORTATION

Taxi service from Colorado Spring to Arnold Hall is approximately \$7.00 each way. If a rental car is desired, it should be arranged individually in advance, as rentals may not be available upon arrival. There are car rentals at the air terminals or through the Colorado Springs and Denver offices of car rental agencies.

ARNOLD HALL

Arnold Hall is the Cadet Social Center and the meeting place for all cadets and their guests. Cadet Duty Officers will be on duty at the Command Post desk during the hours that Arnold Hall is open (7:30 AM to 1:00 AM).
